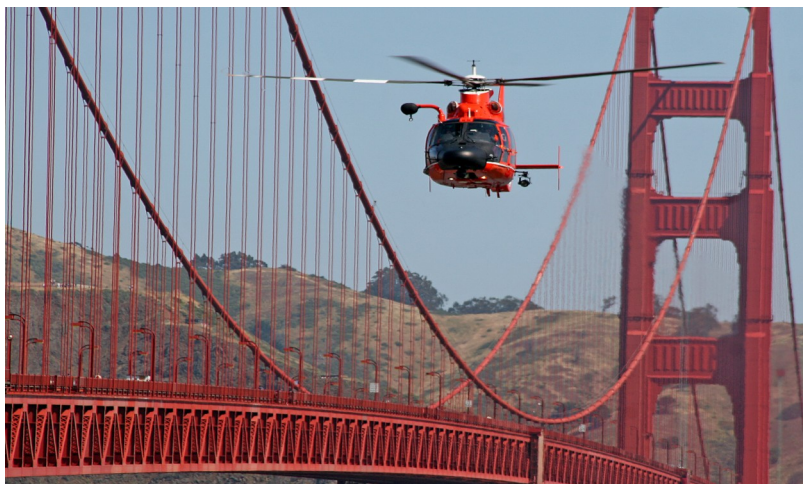

- 203 search and rescue cases, 5 lives saved/13 lives assisted
- Inception of Maritime Industry Rescue Training (MIRT) Program (Tugs and Container ships)
- Joint CGAS LA/CBP Southwest border enforcement; resulting in 23 apprehensions, \$5,000 seized.
- Conducted Joint Maritime Security Exercise with FBI
