U.S. Coast Guard Station Monterey is home to two 47-foot Motor Lifeboats, one 41-foot utility boat, and one 25-foot response boats. The more than 40 member crew who serve here carry out search and rescue, homeland security, marine protection, and maritime law enforcement missions. Additionally, the Station Monterey crew works closely with Fish and Wildlife, Monterey Bay National Marine Sanctuary, and local fire and police departments. The unit's area of responsibility extends 50 miles offshore from Point Ano Nuevo to Point Sur.

- Assisted more than \$3 million worth of property

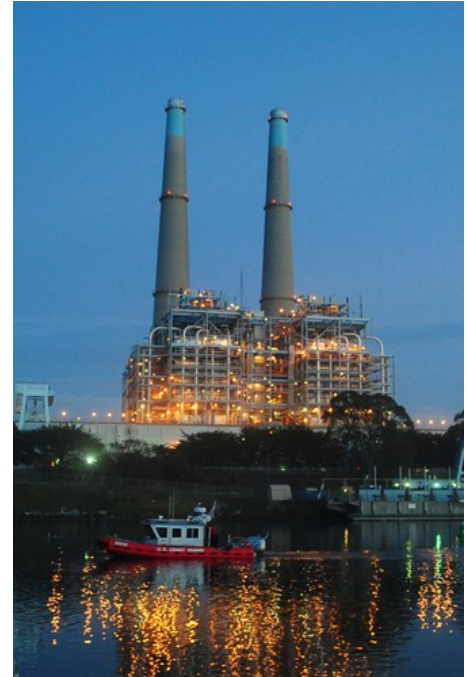
